XII. NEW BUSINESS

The Executive Director reminded the Trustees that travel to the upcoming NEPC Client Conference needed approval.

The Executive Director informed the Trustees that meeting procedures are posted in the boardroom and that the Winter Newsletter's headline article covers COLA requirements and other benefit increase issues.

There was discussion on personnel training, the phone system and a possible dress code, that could be discussed in a Legislative, Rules & Regulations Committee meeting.

XIII. REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

The Executive Director reported that all taxes were filed on time and that all Trustees are eligible to travel. The Executive Director informed the board that Trustee Joseph Clark is non-compliant with the Code of Ethics Policy for not filing an annual disclosure statement by the deadline. There was some discussion on "how to" bring a trustee into compliance with the policy. The Chairman offered to follow-up with a telephone call to get the disclosure filed.
