EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO RETIRE

At a Regular Board of Trustees Meeting held through a Livestream on YouTube on August 17, 2020, the Executive Director, Mr. Andrew Clark, formally announced his intent to retire on October 1, 2020. The Board of Trustees was made aware of Mr. Clark's intent to retire during a closed meeting session in late 2019.

Just prior to the COVID-19 Pandemic, the Board of Trustees hired EFL Associates to assist with the search for a new Executive Director. Once the pandemic hit the area, the search was held up for around two months.

The Board of Trustees resumed the search in earnest earlier this summer by conducting a series of Committee meetings until it became time to make a hiring recommendation to the full Board of Trustees late last month.

NEW EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR HIRED

At a Special Board of Trustees Meeting held through a Livestream on YouTube on August 27, 2020, the Board of Trustees unanimously decided to hire Ms. Susan Kane as the new Executive Director of the Public School Retirement System of the City of St. Louis.

Ms. Kane has served in a similar capacity in St. Louis County government for a number of years and brings ample experience to her new role as Executive Director. To help with a smooth transition from one Executive Director to the other, Ms. Kane will join PSRSSTL later in September.

Please join us in a fond farewell to Mr. Clark for his fifteen years of service to the retirement system, and in welcoming Ms. Kane to the retirement system in her new capacity as Executive Director.

MEMBER BENEFIT STATEMENTS

INSURANCE OPEN ENROLLMENT

The health insurance open enrollment period for 2021 begins soon. Retired members enrolled in medical and dental insurance through PSRSSTL should look for an Open Enrollment Packet in the mail this coming October.

Information regarding open enrollment during the COVID-19 Pandemic will be included with the packet and posted on the website, www.psrsstl.org. Due to the pandemic, there will be no in-person open enrollment meetings held this year.

2020 SECOND QUARTER INVESTMENT BRIEF

"Investing your money for lifetime security"

The Retirement System's investments experienced a positive return of 12.3% during the 2020 Second Quarter, ranking in the top 62% of similar public funds. During the one-year period ending on June 30, 2020, the Retirement System experienced a positive return on investments of 0.7%, a decrease of 6.3% in market value, and ranked in the top 92% of similar public funds. Although the shock on the markets due to the COVID-19 Pandemic earlier this year was alarming, the markets have continued a steady recovery ever snice.
