MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES REGULAR MEETING

October 19, 2020

I. ROLL CALL AND ANNOUNCEMENT OF A QUORUM

The October meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Public School Retirement System of the City of St. Louis (PSRSSTL) was called to order at around 4:35 p.m., Monday, October 19, 2020. The meeting was conducted by video conference through Zoom and a Livestream on YouTube. Louis Cross, Chairman of the Board of Trustees, was the presiding officer.

Roll Call was taken, and Angela Banks, Christina Bennett, Darnetta Clinkscale, Louis Cross, Yvette Levy, Justin Stein, and Bobbie Richardson were present. The Board of Trustees had a quorum at the meeting. Trustee Albert Sanders joined the meeting in progress. Trustees Joseph Clark, Sheila Goodwin, and Donna Jones were absent.

Executive Director, Susan Kane, and Attorney Representative, Matt Gierse, were also in attendance.

II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM LAST MEETING

Christina Bennett made a motion, seconded by Bobbie Richardson, to approve the minutes of the Board of Trustees Meetings on August 17, 2020. By voice vote, motion carried.

III. READING OF COMMUNICATIONS TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

V. CONSENT AGENDA

Christina Bennett made a motion, seconded by Darnetta Clinkscale, to approve the Retirements and Benefits of September and October 2020. By voice vote, motion carried.

Bobbie Richardson made a motion, seconded by Darnetta Clinkscale, to approve the Refunds and Bills of August and September 2020. By voice vote, motion carried.

VI. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Darnetta Clinkscale reviewed the training document approved at the Regular Board Meeting on February 24, 2020. Trustee Clinkscale proposed that the Attorney present a training on Rules and Regulations at the next Investment Committee on November 19, 2020. Trustee Bennett suggested that the Rules and Regulations Committee could meet after the Investment Committee meeting for the training and to review any proposed rule changes. Rules and Regulations Chairman Justin Stein concurred. After discussion, the Trustees agreed to handle this training as part of the Rules and Regulations Committee Meeting to be held after the Investment Committee Meeting on November 19, 2020.

VII. REPORT OF THE CHAIRPERSON

The Chairman reported that the mailing of the 2021 open enrollment materials had not yet gone out. Once all approvals for the benefits being offered had been received, then materials would be printed and mailed to retirees

VIII. REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

The Executive Director began her report by thanking the Board for appointing her to the position. The Executive Director then commented that the invoice for 2019 St. Louis Public Schools pension contribution had been sent to the Board of Education and payment was due to be received by December 31, 2020. Charter School notices would be sent out later.

The Executive Director provided additional information regarding the open enrollment period and that only retirees wanting to make a change would need to take action. Additional resources, such as recorded presentations from each of the vendors, would be posted on the website.

The Executive Director updated the Trustees on new telephone procedures within the PSRS office that would better ensure callers would speak to a representative more quickly instead of having to go through telephone prompts before speaking to someone. Finally, the Executive Director commented that it was close to Budget time and the Trustee Business Committee typically met in early December to review Trustee Travel and the following year's budget. The Chairman had commented earlier that he would need to appoint someone to Chair the Budget Committee but withdrew that comment when Trustee Clinkscale indicated that she was Chair of the Trustee Business Committee. A meeting will be set with this Committee in early December to review the 2021 Operating Budget.

X. REPORT OF THE ACTUARY

The Chairman asked for an update on a report that the Actuary was going to perform to ensure that there were no payments being made to deceased members. The Chairman was concerned that the current system was not adequately catching all such situations. The Attorney commented that he believed that a resolution was reached between the former Executive Director and the Actuary but was not sure if a report was created. The Executive Director will check with the Actuary and report back to the Board on the status of this and any recommendations regarding this process.

XI. REPORTS OF COMMITTEES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Chairman asked for reports from the Committees.

The Chairman commented that the mailing of the open enrollment materials would occur soon.

Investment Committee

Investment Committee Chairman Christina Bennett reported that at the Investment Committee Meeting on October 15, 2020 a recommendation had been made regarding terminating the relationship with LMCG Emerging Markets Fund due to their closure. The Attorney affirmed that the full Board needed to approve this recommendation.

Investment Committee Chair Bennett made a motion, seconded by Yvette Levy, to liquidate the funds in the LMCG Emerging Markets fund, move to cash and terminate the relationship.

The Chairman thanked Trustee Levy for her support and assistance during the search for a new Executive Director.

XII. NEW BUSINESS

Trustee Bennett presented six Amendments to the Rules and Regulations. The Amendments were read at the meeting and will be discussed at the Rules and Regulation Meeting on November 19, 2020.

To amend Rule II, Section 2, as follows:

Section 2. Duties such as preparation of minutes of the meetings of the Board of Trustees and its committees and record maintenance, which are typically performed by an organization's secretary, shall be the responsibility of the Executive Director; or a designated staff person¹, however, the Executive Director or a designated staff person¹, shall not be a Member or Officer of the Board of Trustees.

To amend Rule IV, Section 2, as follows:

Section 2. The Treasurer shall be elected at the regular October meeting in each odd numbered year for a two-year term of office which shall commence January 1 the succeeding even numbered year. Treasurer can be any Trustee other than an elected officer.

(Chairperson or Vice Chairperson) 1

To amend Rule VI, Section 1, as follows:

Section 1. No later than February 1¹ of each year, the Chairperson of the Board of Trustees shall establish such Committees to serve for the current year for such purposes as the Chairperson deems appropriate; and the Chairperson may dissolve any Committee so appointed with the approval of the Board of Trustees. Each such Committee shall be charged with the duty to meet and recommend action to the Board of Trustees on matters within the scope of the Committee's purpose, but shall have no authority to take action on behalf of the Board of Trustees. If the February 1st deadline is not adhered to by the Chairperson of the Board of Trustees, then the Vice Chairperson shall establish such Committees to allow the continuance of business¹.

To amend Rule VI, Section 2, as follows:

Section 2. Each Committee shall be a "committee of the whole", made up of all Board Members.

The Chairperson of the Board of Trustees shall appoint a chairperson and/or a Co
Chair¹ for each Committee, except him or herself¹, subject to approval by the Board of Trustees. Each Committee shall meet from time to time at the call of the Chairperson of the Committee. Decisions made by Committees shall be put on the agenda of the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Trustees, unless an earlier special meeting of the Board of Trustees is called for the purpose of considering a Committee's decision.

To amend Rule VIII, Section 2 Item f, as follows:

- Section 2. The duties of the Executive Director shall include, but shall not be limited to the following:
 - f. prepare an annual report of the Retirement System to be distributed to members of the St. Louis Board of Education, Members of the Board of Trustees, and members of the Retirement System. <u>Such report shall include membership, total annual pension</u>

payments for the year, composite of membership, summary chart of benefit calculations, financing summary, summary of its assets and its asset allocation, snapshot of investment performance history. See sample document attached¹.

To amend Rule XI, Section 1, as follows:

Section 1. All meetings and records of the Public School Retirement System of the City of St. Louis shall be open to the public, except when otherwise authorized under the provisions of Section 610.010 to 610.030 R.S.Mo. 1978, as amended. In addition, all retiree data and system data shall be made public via a sunshine request and is required to be produced upon request under the provision of RS MO. 610.021(13)¹.

The Chairman brought up the PSRS office closure and led a discussion on if it was time for the office to reopen to remain parallel with the St. Louis Public Schools reopening. The Attorney said that he had not reviewed any policies or issues regarding the office opening for a few months and would like to take some time to review it again since the situation was continually changing. The Trustees were in agreement that if the office did reopen that PPE and other safety measures should be provided to staff along with limits on the number of individuals entering the office at one time. The Attorney and the Executive Director will review and discuss with the Board at a future date.

XIII. REPORT OF THE ATTORNEY

The Attorney provided an update on the appeal to the Missouri State Supreme Court in the lawsuit regarding Senate Bill 62. The appeal was filed on October 2, 2020 and a decision on whether the Court will hear the appeal is anticipated by the end of November. The Attorney explained that only a limited number of cases are heard but there are a number of unique issues so the Court may want to review the case. The Chairman asked if there was any recourse to the United States Supreme Court if the appeal was not heard or denied but the Attorney explained that the Missouri State Supreme Court was the last step for the appeal. The Chairman thanked the Attorney for all the work on the issue.

XIV. ADJOURNMENT

Christina Bennett made a motion, seconded by Yvette Levy, to adjourn the meeting. By voice vote, motion carried, and the meeting adjourned at around 5:50 p.m.
