MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES REGULAR MEETING

October 27, 2021

I. ROLL CALL AND ANNOUNCEMENT OF A QUORUM

The October meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Public School Retirement System of the City of St. Louis (PSRSSTL) was called to order at around 4:37 p.m. on Wednesday, October 27, 2021. The meeting was conducted by video conference through Zoom and a Livestream on YouTube. Louis Cross, Chairman of the Board of Trustees, was the presiding officer.

Chairman Cross then commented that Trustee meeting attendance was very high and thanked the Trustees for their participation and work on key issues that will benefit the members of the System.

VIII. REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

The Executive Director began by presenting a report regarding Overpayments Made to Deceased Retirees. One large overpayment for a retiree who was deceased in 2019 but continued to receive their benefit payment through late 2020 was fully recovered. PSRSSTL Staff was working on a recommendation to present to the Trustees for death audit process in 2022.

The Executive Director also provided some phone statistics on calls received, calls live answered, and average talk time for the period through September as well as an update on completion of Property Management projects with repaving of the parking lot and installation of new equipment in the Boardroom.
